Reflection Questions:

- What is one thing that you know is true? (Don't overthink it just share the first thing that comes to your mind.)
- What stood out to you from Sunday's service? How did you sense God at work in you through the songs, the message, and being together with others as part of the church? (The message main points and scripture are listed below if it helps you think back.)
- Eddie shared that, "Our impulse is to seek affirmation, not correction." Have you seen this to be true in your life? In others?
- Read John 1:14. Eddie shared, "Truth exists in the Person of Jesus Christ and we can know the truth through him." How does this verse and quote challenge you? How does it comfort you?
- Read 1 John 1:8. Eddie invited us to say out loud, "I have a sin problem" H invited us to be honest about our susceptibility speaking the truth in love to ourselves about ourselves. What does it feel like to say something like that out loud?
- Henry Cloud observed, "Spiritual transformation requires grace + truth + time." Which part of that equation do you need to embrace? How might you do that?
- In the sermon, Eddie offered three sources for us to trust:
 - Trust the Bible over your feelings. (Feelings are always real, but not always true.)
 - Trust the saints over celebrities.
 - Trust the church over culture.

Which of those do you need to hold onto this week?

- Read Hebrews 13:7. Who are some of the saints whose example and wisdom inspire you in your faith? Share some of their names and stories with one another.
- How do you need to embrace truth today? Get practical! Write some next steps down and share them with someone.
