Scripture:

"The God of our ancestors has chosen you to know his will and to see the Righteous One and hear him speak. For you are to be his witness, telling everyone what you have seen and heard. What are you waiting for? Get up and be baptized. Have your sins washed away by calling on the name of the Lord."

Acts 22:14-16

Then Jesus went from Galilee to the Jordan River to be baptized by John. But John tried to talk him out of it. "I am the one who needs to be baptized by you," he said, "so why are you coming to me?" But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires." So John agreed to baptize him.

Reflection Questions:

- What is one spontaneous choice you've made in your life? Why did you do it?
- Have you been baptized by immersion? If so, what do you remember about your baptism experience?
- What stood out to you from Sunday's service? How did you sense God encouraging and challenging you through the songs, the message, and being with others as part of the church? (The message's main points and scripture are listed below if it helps you think back.)

- Read Acts 22:14-16. What do you notice about Ananias' words to Saul (who we know as Paul)?
- In the message, Eddie shared that in a world of schedules, there is something especially meaningful about someone making a bold decision on the spot, in the moment. Then, he shared, "if you begin doing what Jesus wants IN REAL-TIME, your growth will be OFF THE CHARTS." Is there something you know God wants you to do right now? What is it and what is holding you back?
- People often feel they need more information, knowledge, or understanding before taking a spiritual step. Do you ever notice this in yourself? When and why?
- Eddie shared, "God doesn't call us to be his experts. He calls us to be his witness." How do you react to that encouragement?
- Read Matthew 3:13. What do you notice about Jesus' example in his baptism?
- Read Jesus' words in Matthew 28:18-20. These are familiar verses to many believers; read them in several different translations if they're words you've heard often. What stands out about Jesus' commands here?
- In the message, Eddie said, "When Jesus wants something from you, don't schedule it do it."
 - o If you've never been baptized, what is holding you back? How can you explore that more?
 - o Is there another part of Jesus' commands that you know you need to obey today? What can you do right now to follow him?
- Is there anything else from this teaching that you want to explore more?
- Take time to pray as you close your time of reflection or discussion, asking God to help you act on what he has asked you to do.
