

People to Watch Out For 4 – Money Chasers Discussion & Reflection Guide

Message & Scripture Discussion

- What do you think it means to be truly wealthy? How would you know if you were wealthy?
- What stood out to you from Sunday's service? How did you sense God at work in you through the songs, the story video, the message, and being together with others as part of the church? (The message's main points and scripture are listed below if it helps you think back.)
- Eddie offered several questions for us to consider thoughtfully. Look over each one and write down an honest answer:
 - How much of my thought-life revolves around money, possessions and luxuries?
 - o Am I overly emotional about financial and material things?
 - o Do I seek ways to be generous, or do I avoid generosity?

Look over your answers to these questions. What do you notice?

- Read 1 Timothy 6:6-10. These are Paul's wise words to a younger leader, Timothy. What pieces of wisdom in these verses stand out to you today? Have you seen people do what verses 9-10 describe?
- Eddie shared 4 indicators that something is off in our approach to money. Read over them and mark which ones you need to watch out for:
 - o Questionable or secretive financial behavior
 - o Constant conversation about money and material things
 - o Financial priorities outrank spiritual priorities
 - o When our people feel less important to us than our money

Even if it's not at a concerning place yet, which of these signs do you need to pay close attention?

- Read Luke 16:13 or if you have time, read Luke 16:1-13 (to see the parable Jesus shares). What do you notice in Jesus' words?
- Finally, Eddie shared 3 practical application suggestions:
 - Spend the rest of this year and next year defining true wealth and making a plan to pursue it
 - o Determine to live well within your resources
 - o Pray for a generous spirit and test your generosity muscles.
