

#### Wonderland Week 3 Discussion & Reflection Guide

# **Questions and Prompts**

- What stood out to you from Sunday's service? How did you sense God at work in you through the songs, the story video, the message, and being together with others as part of the church? (The message's main points and scripture are listed below if it helps you think back.)
- **"Physical presence that communicates far more than words.** Do you remember a time when someone was with you in a way that meant a lot to you? Who was it and why do you remember it?
- "So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son." John 1:14. Print or **write out this verse** and put it somewhere you'll see often this week.
  - Read this challenge from Chip: "If you really want to step into and wade in the TRUE WONDER of this season... You might get a towel and a basin... And Wash someone's feet... Maybe Hug a leper... Welcome in one standing on the outside... Eat a simple meal with someone loved by God... Hold the hand of someone in a hospital bed... Make yourself fully present—physically present—with someone who is lonely... ...And longing to see God. And show them God. Show them what it looks like when God makes His dwelling among us." What's ONE way you can be present to someone this week?
- Is there anything else from the message you want to explore more deeply this week?

### Message Main Points & Scripture

- John 1:1-3 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made."
