

Higher Definition 2 – TRUST Discussion & Reflection Guide

Message & Scripture Discussion

- What's one of your favorite ways to spend or use your money?
- What stood out to you from Sunday's service? How did you sense God at work in you through the songs, the story video, the message, and being together with others as part of the church? (The message's main points and scripture are listed below if it helps you think back.)
- What words or images come to your mind when you hear the word, "trust?"
- Eddie shared, "All of us decide which internal voice we will amplify and obey." When it comes to money and giving, what are some of the voices and messages that go through your mind? As you list them, think about where each one comes from.
- Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-15.
 - What images or phrases stand out to you from this passage?
 - o Is there anything that comforts you?
 - o What challenges you?
- Take a moment to read this statement from Eddie: "God wants to fund his church through the faithfulness of his people." **How do you react to this?**
- Take a moment to answer this question: What does it look like to trust God with my money? Get practical and specific.
- Eddie shared several examples from the Bible about how to demonstrate trust in God with our money:
 - God wants me to give to him first, not last. (This often means budgeting and avoiding unwise debt.)
 - o God wants me to give joyfully, not with resentment. (Don't break the cycle. If God has blessed you, and you've blessed others because of it, keep going.)
 - o God wants me to give through faith, not fear. (God loves to be trusted.)

Which of these comes most naturally to you? Which one is a struggle?

- Honestly reflect on how you are trusting God. Take a moment to talk to Him about the specifics of what you notice (both internally and externally). What do you want to say to God about all of this?
- Is there anything else from the message you want to explore more deeply this week?

 do you mean? When did we ever cheat you?' You have cheated me of the tithes and
 offerings due to me. You are under a curse, for your whole nation has been cheating
 me. Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my
