

# Made for This Week 3 – Built Different Groups Guide

#### Introduction & Icebreaker (10 minutes)

 Give EVERYONE a chance to share something as you start. What's one of the most incredible places or things in nature you've ever seen – something that makes you say, "wow!"?

#### **Message & Scripture Discussion (30 minutes)**

There are likely more questions here than you need. Choose from them and try to dig into the message through Scripture, discussion, and practical application. Don't feel like you have to ask every single question.

- What stood out to you from Sunday's service? How did you sense God at work in you through the songs, the story video, the message, and being together with others as part of the church? (The message's main points and scripture are listed below if it helps you think back.)
- In the sermon, Eddie took us back to the very beginning of creation. Have someone read Genesis 1:24-28 out loud. What do you notice about God's work of creation in these verses?
- Being made in God's image means every human has value and also has responsibility. In light of the scripture you just read (Gen. 1:24-28), what do you notice about these two realities?
- Eddie talked about the Trinity one God in three persons. It is difficult to grasp intellectually, but it shows that God exists in distinct persons and also in community. **How does God as three-in-one help you understand what he is like?**
- In Genesis 3:21, God makes clothing for Adam and Eve from animal skins. God did this for them (in ways they could not do for themselves), and it required sacrifice. How does this help you understand what God did for us through Jesus and his sacrifice? How does this show how God cherishes and values people?
- In the message, Eddie gave several applications from the teaching:
  - You are both an individual and part of a whole. This is not the Nirvana view (universal consciousness) or the secular view (no God, no eternity). The biblical view is distinct.

- o **How we treat others is how we treat God.** (Matthew 25:40 "Whatever you did (or did not do) for the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.")
- "The image of God in other people matters to God. Let's make certain it matters to us."

With your group, brainstorm some practical applications from these thoughts. What would it look like to live this out?

Is there anything else from the message that you want to explore more this week?

Take a moment to complete the following prompts:

## Daily Time With God Debrief (25 minutes)

Using the notes in your book, give people an opportunity to share anything they are willing from their daily time with God.

- Look through your week of reading through Colossians and using SOAP to take notes. Was there a Scripture that stood out to you as you read this week?
- What is one thing you want to apply or put into practice from your Bible reading this week? (Use your SOAP notes to look back.)
- Did you write down anything on your gratitude list that you'd be willing to share?
- Open your book to page 30. Share your experience of reading through the book of Colossians. What stands out to you from this experience? Is there anything you want help with before we start a new book next week?
- Look at pages 34-35 to see some notes about reading through Ephesians.

# Prayer (10 minutes)

- Invite group members to quickly share one way the group can pray for them this week.
- Have one person from your group (the leader or a volunteer) pray out loud to close your group time.
